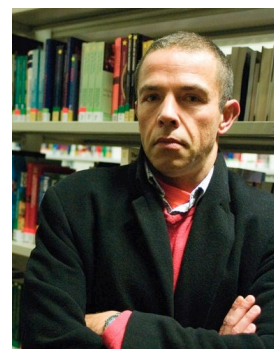

David Chandler is Professor of International Relations at the Centre for the Study of Democracy, University of Westminster. He is a regular media commentator, editor of the *Journal of Intervention and Statebuilding* and the editor of the Routledge book series *Studies in Intervention and Statebuilding*. He is the author of many monographs, including: *Hollow Hegemony: Rethinking Global Politics, Power and Resistance* (Pluto, 2009); *Empire in Denial: The Politics of State-Building* (Pluto, 2006); *Constructing Global Civil Society: Morality and Power in International Relations* (Palgrave-Macmillan, 2004, 2005); *From Kosovo to Kabul (and Beyond): Human Rights and International Intervention* (Pluto, 2002, 2006); and *Bosnia: Faking Democracy after Dayton* (Pluto, 1999, 2000).
